- 2. Educate students and staff about the harmful effects and serious consequences of ragging.
- 3. Provide a proper system to address and resolve complaints related to ragging.
- 4. Support and assist victims of ragging to ensure their safety and well-being.
- 5. Enforce UGC and Supreme Court guidelines on anti-ragging measures.

Committee Guidelines:

- If Ombudsman is attending the meeting, he/she shall chair the committee.
- Orientation sessions for new students and parents must be conducted at the start of the academic year to inform them about the anti-ragging policy.
- Regular workshops, seminars, and expert talks shall be organized to spread awareness.
- Anti-ragging posters and signages will be displayed prominently across the campus and hostels.
- All students and parents must sign an anti-ragging undertaking at the time of admission, as per UGC regulations.
- The committee will conduct regular and surprise inspections in hostels, canteens, and other areas to prevent ragging.
- Complaints will be acknowledged immediately, and an investigation will be conducted fairly and transparently.
- A dedicated investigation team will review complaints and recommend strict disciplinary action if necessary.
- Punishments may include suspension, expulsion, or legal action, as per university rules and UGC guidelines.
- Detailed records of all complaints, investigations, and actions taken will be maintained.
- The committee will submit regular reports to university leadership and UGC.
- The committee will meet **frequently** (**Once in a Week**) for the first three months of each new session, then **once a month**. Reports must be submitted to the Registrar.
